KCCT founder Thomas Twohey to retire after 30 years

Thomas Twohey, who helped launch one of Greater Washington's largest architecture firms, is stepping down.

Twohey plans to retire from District-based Karn Charuhas Chapman and Twohey PC on the firm's 30th anniversary April 1, the firm announced. Twohey, principal in charge of business administration, is one of four founders who launched the company

Twohey helped lead KCCT projects including the [National Building Museum](#) and Ariel Rios Federal Building facades. As Twohey prepares to step down, KCCT also announced that it has hired [Kevin Nisson](#) as its new chief financial officer.
